

Financial Obligations for F-1 Students

Tuition \$18,000.00 Academic Fees \$1,300.00 Registration Fee \$200.00

Uniforms \$350.00 (minimum) Host Fee \$12,500.00 (housing)

I-901 Fee \$350.00 (if Sunrise is providing)

Shipping Fee \$100.00 (See other expenses regarding this fee.)

Extracurricular Fee \$250.00 (Per Sport)

Insurance Fee \$1,750.00 (Applies if student has no proof of insurance)

Inter. Stud. Coordinator \$2,500.00

*Host Fee — From \$7,000 - \$12,500, contact your coordinating agency for exact amount. Do not plan to arrive prior to August 12th unless special arrangements are made.

Insurance is required — This fee is not applied if you can prove that the student has an insurance policy in force with a recognized insurance carrier accepted in the U.S. A copy of the insurance card should be included with the **initial paperwork. If satisfactory proof of insurance is not provided at registration, then SCA will arrange for coverage through a company that services international students. We estimate the fee will be \$1,750.00 and will provide insurance coverage for the duration of the school year: approximately 10 months. Insurance provided by SCA has a \$250.00 deductible and does not cover pre-existing conditions.

***Tuition and Academic Fees are not refundable once school has begun.

Other expenses:

- If a student is graduating from SCA, then there will be costs associated with graduation; i.e., cap and gown, reception fees, etc., costing approximately \$75-\$100.
- School Uniforms: Students must follow SCA clothing guidelines, and must purchase clothing from a designated uniform provider.
- Tuition, Academic Fees, Registration, Uniforms and Insurance (if provided by Sunrise Christian Academy) are required to be paid in full at the time of admission.
 Payment may be made by: wire transfer, check or an approved credit card.
- If additional shipping is required, fees will be assessed at registration.

Air transportation to and from the student's home country is the responsibility of the student/parents. Students are required to have a round trip ticket. Before leaving your country, SCA and your host family must be aware of your itinerary. In case of emergency while traveling, you may contact the school office at 316-744-9262.

International Students should arrive no earlier than one week prior to the first day of class and must depart the United States no later than one week after classes have ended unless prior arrangements have been made.
